



## Caroline Taylor Davis

July 13, 1942 - October 3, 2018

Caroline Taylor Davis, died on October 3, 2018, at Baptist Hospital as a result of pulmonary failure. She was born in Louisville on July 13, 1942, the first daughter of the late O. Lloyd Taylor and Jean Bromme Taylor. She is survived by her husband of 52 years, William Watkins Davis; her daughter, Caroline Davis Stites (Win); her son, John Haden Davis (Laura); five grandchildren, Caroline Puryear, Abigail Davis, Allison Davis, Allen Stites, and Scott Davis; a sister, Susan T. Volkerding (John); a brother-in-law, Mark B. Davis (Kate); and four nieces and two nephews. She was preceded in death by her sister, Mimi Osborn.

Caroline was a graduate of the Kentucky Home School and the University of Kentucky College of Education. She taught elementary school in the Jefferson County school system for several years and, after raising her children, she embarked on a new career with a travel agency for almost 20 years. She was a member of Delta Delta Delta sorority, a sustaining member of the Junior League, a former member of the Younger Women's Club of Louisville and a volunteer at several nonprofit institutions. She was a lifelong member of St. Francis in the Fields Episcopal Church, where she was among the first to attend the church Sunday school program, sang in the choir as a teenager, was married, and served on the alter guild and other volunteer positions.

Caroline was an avid bridge player, excellent cook, travelled extensively in this country and abroad and relished being with her family and many friends. Her ingratiating smile and good cheer endeared her to all she met, and the love extended to her husband, children, grandchildren, family and friends will be sorely missed.

A memorial service will be held at 1:00 pm, Monday, October 8, 2018 at St. Francis in the Fields Episcopal Church, 6710 Wolf Pen Branch Road, Harrods Creek, Kentucky. A reception and visitation will follow at the church.
