Sherrill Gordon Williams, aged 83, died peacefully on January 10, 2020 at the Episcopal Church Home, Louisville, KY, after a courageous battle with dementia. Sherrill was born December 21, 1936, in Louisville, KY, the daughter of Sherrill Thirlwell and Nebby Gordon. Sherrill attended Eastern High School in Louisville and graduated in 1954. She was a varsity cheerleader and proudly served on reunion committees with a devotion to keeping in touch with classmates. Family was Sherrill's passion and delight. She loved to host and entertain at her house, surrounded by loved ones. Sherrill was a gifted pianist, and always was able to light up a room with beautiful and lively music. In addition to raising four children, Sherrill worked with children of special needs both at Roberta Tully School and Churchill Park. From there, she was a fundamental innovator of the Disabled Citizens Computer Center, known as enTech today. Often, Sherrill and Jim were spotted cruising along the Ohio River enjoying their boat and friends they met along the riverside.

Sherrill is survived by her loving husband, Jim Williams; her sister, Marilyn McCarthy-Brunnhoeffer and her husband, Jim Brunnhoeffer; her two daughters, Debbie (Jeff) Durling and Tracy (Rod) McClanahan; her two sons, Richard (Lynne) Dukes and Kevin (Christy) Williams; her granddaughters, Megan McClanahan and Grace Dukes; her grandson, Carson Dukes; two nephews, Brian McCarthy and Darin McCarthy; and a number of other relatives and close friends.
