Steven M. Garrett, 59, of Louisville, KY died surrounded by family on February 25, 2019 following a hard-fought, 15-month battle with Pancreatic cancer.

Steve graduated as the Valedictorian from Waggener High School in 1977 and continued on to Rhodes College in Memphis, TN where he graduated Magna Cum Laude in 1981 with a degree in Chemistry. Later that year, following his father and grandfather into the family business, he pursued his life-long career with Garrett-Stotz Company where he served as Chief Financial Officer.
